To my Council Colleagues,

I apologize for my absence from tonight's meeting. Family obligations have prevented me from attending; however, I thought it important to convey my support for **Ordinance Z-1**.

The Zoning and Planning Committee, consisting of Chairperson Marsh, Councilperson Mello, and myself, had a three-way phone conversation, which resulted in unanimous support for the ordinance.

Although I encourage the City Council to support **Ordinance Z-1**, I have two areas of concern that I feel must eventually be addressed:

- 1. The appeal process needs to be more clearly defined. Courts should not be the only recourse for applicants who wish to appeal a decision of the Zoning Board.
- 2. The Mayor and the City Council should both be involved in the selection process. I believe the decision to appoint members to the board should not lye solely in the hands of either the Mayor or the City Council. A compromise between these two entities of municipal government is the optimal scenario.

For these reasons I feel the ordinance should be revisited in the near future, and ultimately the Mayor and the City Council should work in collaboration when choosing members, and governing this board.
