

RESOLUTION:

Whereas, on September 28, 2001, Mayor David Roberts vetoed Ordinance #12, an Ordinance Amending and Supplementing Part II General Legislation of the "Code of the City of Hoboken" by adding a New Chapter 147 entitled MOBILE TELEPHONES, which was unanimously passed by the Hoboken City Council.

Whereas, the Hoboken City Council believes that the operation of motor vehicles on public roadways while using mobile telephones may cause the operation to maintain less that fulltime attention to the operation of said motor vehicles.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Hoboken believes that the regulations of the use of mobile telephones while operating motor vehicles within the City will enhance the safety of those persons operating motor vehicles as well as pedestrians in the City.

Whereas, it is the intension of this City Council to join with other municipalities throughout the State who have adopted this Ordinance, and to urge our County and State Legislators to extend this "CELL PHONE BAN" State wide.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Hoboken takes this opportunity to exercise their right to take a vote to overturn the Veto imposed by Mayor David Robers.
