**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 190 OF THE
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE CITY OF HOBOKEN ENTITLED
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,
ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 4, 1991 AS ORDINANCE #2278**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HOBOKEN DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**ARTICLE V
LOADING ZONES**

190-11 Loading Zone

Section 1. The locations described are hereby designated as loading zones. No person shall park a vehicle in said loading zones during the times indicated other than for the loading or unloading of goods and materials.

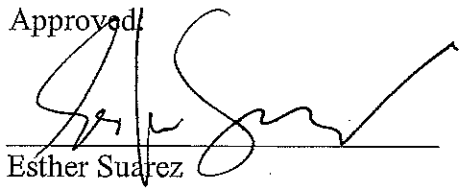
NAME OF STREET	TIME	SIDE	LOCATION
Second Street	8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Mon. – Sat.	North	Beginning at a point of 35' ft. west of the westerly curblin of River Street and extending 44' ft. westerly therefrom.
Third Street	8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Mon. – Sat.	South	Beginning at a point of 35' ft. west of the westerly curblin of River Street and extending 44' ft. westerly therefrom.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Proper signs shall be erected in accordance with the current "Manual on Traffic Control Devices."

Section 4. This ordinance shall be part of the Hoboken code as though codified and fully set forth therein. The City Clerk shall have this ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Hoboken.
