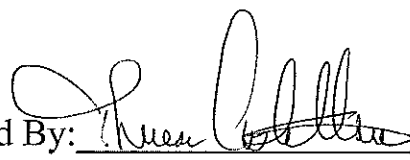
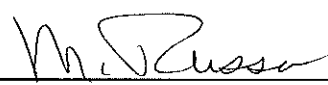

RESOLUTION IN CONNECTION WITH SALE OF MUNICIPAL GARAGE

WHEREAS, the intention of the Hoboken City Council is to determine the most beneficial resolution regarding the Municipal Garage, Newmann Leather and Rezoning matters. (Refer to attached block, location and lot.)

WHEREAS, it is the will of this City Council to take into consideration the public input, concerns and comments. The compiling of this information is invaluable and enables the City Council to come to a favorable conclusion for all parties concerned.

NOW, therefore be resolved by the Council of the City of Hoboken and County of Hudson that:

- 1) The Mayor appoints concerned citizens and the number of volunteers should reflect at least 2 residents of each effected site.
- 2) The panel will also include 2 councilpersons as liaisons to the entire council.
